Mrs. Greszler is recognized as an economic expert in workforce, retirement, and fiscal issues. She researches and writes about expanding employment opportunities; workplace policies; Social Security; disability insurance; pensions; and improper federal government payments. She recently published a piece explaining why the WEP and GPO were established, how the WEP and GPO affect benefit calculations, and calling on Congress to pass a “fair correction” to the WEP and GPO.

Mrs. Greszler is also a Senior Research Fellow in Economics, Budget, and Entitlements at the Heritage Foundation. Before joining Heritage in 2013, she was a senior economist for the Joint Economic Committee for seven years.
