Dr. Philip serves as the Chief Medical Officer of Value-Based Care (VBC) for Duly Health and Care, which serves about 90,000 VBC patients. He completed undergrad and medical school training at Northwestern University and residency at the University of Illinois. He has extensive experience working with Medicare Advantage, ACO REACH, MSSP ACO as well as a variety of upside/downside commercial VBC contracts.

As an internal medicine physician by training, he currently practices medicine in a high risk VBC clinics called Breakthrough Care Centers, where they focus on the 5% of patients who drive up to 50% of healthcare costs. The Duly team has also facilitated ambulatory surgery cases such as total joint replacements, to our Ambulatory Surgery Centers (ASC). These ASC cases have demonstrated decreased infections, lower complication rates, less readmissions and a significant cost reduction by avoiding hospital facility fees. Dr. Philip has also overseen a mobile integrated health program. Duly has seen several of our programs drive significant patient value within our health system and at the state level.
