Dr. Miller runs a multi-disciplinary, fifteen-person research group that analyzes market-driven solutions in FDA regulatory policy and Medicare payment policy. Research by his team has been published in *The New England Journal of Medicine, JAMA, Tobacco Control, BMJ,* and *Health Affairs Forefront* among other venues. Trained and board-certified in preventive medicine and internal medicine, Dr. Miller has broad regulatory experience at the Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Services, the Federal Trade Commission, the Federal Communications Commission, and the U.S. Food and Drug Administration. Dr. Miller is a Commissioner on the Medicare Payment Advisory Commission, a Trustee for the North Carolina State Health Plan, and a member of the National Advisory Council for the Advancing a Healthier Wisconsin Endowment. He serves as an advisor to members of Congress and other elected officials and lives in Washington, D.C.
