Adrien Lewis is the founder of CarePortal, the first Care-Sharing platform designed to connect agencies, churches, businesses, and communities in real time. He began his career in business development, working across healthcare, technology, and education before a mission trip to Haiti with his wife, Cynthia, transformed his perspective and deepened his faith. Over the next three years, he volunteered with The Global Orphan Project, where he witnessed firsthand the power of connection in caring for vulnerable children.

In 2010, Adrien felt a clear call from God to leave the business world and dedicate himself to serving orphaned and abandoned children. This journey led him and Cynthia to become foster and adoptive parents, giving them a deeply personal view of the challenges families face in crisis. Out of that lived experience, Adrien launched CarePortal in 2015 with a vision: to make Care-Sharing as common and accessible as ride-sharing, empowering communities to respond to families with dignity, speed, and love. Today, CarePortal has become a national movement, connecting more than half a million children and caregivers with local responders and opening pathways for trust, stability, and restoration.
