

Kent Smetters, PhD Professor of Business Economics and Public Policy, University of Pennsylvania's Wharton School

Dr. Smetters is the Boettner Chair Professor at the University of Pennsylvania's Wharton School and the Faculty Director at the Penn Wharton Budget Model. His research focuses on applied theory, optimal fiscal policy, personal finance, and asset pricing. Previous policy positions include the Congressional Budget Office (1995–1998), as well as Economics Policy Coordinator (Deputy Assistant Secretary) for the U.S. Department of the Treasury (2001–2002). He was the Kaiser Visiting Professor of Economics at Stanford University's Economics Department from 2000 to 2001. He has published academic articles in leading journals, including *American Economic Review*, *Journal of Political Economy*, and the *Quarterly Journal of Economics*.
