# **A BILL**

To designate the building utilized as a United States courthouse located at 150 Reade Circle in Greenville, North Carolina, as the “Judge Randy D. Doub United States Courthouse”.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. DESIGNATION.**

4 *The building utilized as a United States courthouse*  
5 *located at 150 Reade Circle in Greenville, North Carolina,*  
6 *shall be known and designated as the “Randy D. Doub*  
7 *United States Courthouse” during the period in which the*  
8 *building is utilized as a United States courthouse.*

9 **SEC. 2. REFERENCES.**

10 *With respect to the period in which the building re-*  
11 *ferred to in section 1 is utilized as a United States court-*  
12 *house, any reference in a law, map, regulation, document,*  
13 *paper, or other record of the United States to that building*  
14 *shall be deemed to be a reference to the “Randy D. Doub*  
15 *United States Courthouse”.*

Amend the title so as to read: “A bill to designate the building utilized as a United States courthouse located at 150 Reade Circle in Greenville, North Carolina, as the ‘Randy D. Doub United States Courthouse’.”.
