A BILL

To amend the Real ID Act of 2005 to permit Freely Associated States to meet identification requirements under such Act, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “REAL ID Act Modi-
5 fication for Freely Associated States Act”.

6 **SEC. 2. AMENDMENT.**

7 (a) DEFINITION OF STATE.—Section 201(5) of the
8 Real ID Act of 2005 (49 U.S.C. 30301 note; Public Law
9 109–13) is amended by striking “the Trust Territory of
10 the Pacific Islands,”.

11 (b) EVIDENCE OF LAWFUL STATUS.—Section
12 202(c)(2)(B) of the REAL ID Act of 2005 (49 U.S.C.
13 30301 note; Public Law 109–13) is amended—

14 (1) in clause (viii), by striking “or” at the end;

15 (2) in clause (ix), by striking the period at the
16 end and inserting “; or”; and

17 (3) by adding at the end the following:

18 “(x) is a citizen of the Republic of the
19 Marshall Islands, the Federated States of
20 Micronesia, or the Republic of Palau who
21 has been admitted to the United States as
22 a nonimmigrant pursuant to a Compact of
23 Free Association between the United
24 States and the Republic or Federated
25 States.”.
