- 4 shall submit to Congress a proposal for consolidating in-
- 5 formation technology across the Federal Government, es-
- 6 pecially among Federal agencies not referred to under sec-
- 7 tion 901(b) of title 31, United States Code, and increasing
- 8 the use of shared services, including any recommendations
- 9 for legislative changes that may be necessary to effect the
- 10 proposal.

11 SEC. 4. NO ADDITIONAL FUNDS AUTHORIZED.

- 12 No additional funds are authorized to be appro-
- 13 priated to carry out this Act and the amendments made
- 14 by this Act. This Act and the amendments made by this
- 15 Act shall be carried out using amounts otherwise author-
- 16 ized.
