Mr. RUSSELL (for himself, Mr. KATKO, and Mrs. WATSON COLEMAN) introduced the following bill; which was referred to the Committee on Oversight and Government Reform

A BILL

To amend the Overtime Pay for Protective Services Act of 2016 to extend the Secret Service overtime pay exception through 2019, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Secret Service Over-
5 time Pay Extension Act”.

1 **SEC. 2. EXTENSION OF OVERTIME PAY EXCEPTION**
2 **THROUGH 2020 FOR PROTECTIVE SERVICES.**

3 (a) IN GENERAL.—Section 2 of the Overtime Pay for
4 Protective Services Act of 2016 (5 U.S.C. 5547 note), as
5 amended by Public Law 115–160, is further amended—

6 (1) in the section heading, by striking “**2018**”
7 and inserting “**2020**”;

8 (2) in subsection (a), by striking “or 2018” and
9 inserting “2018, 2019, or 2020”; and

10 (3) in subsection (b)(1), by striking “and
11 2018” and inserting “2018, 2019, and 2020”.

12 (b) REPORT ON EXTENSIONS.—Not later than Janu-
13 ary 30 of each of calendar years 2020 and 2021, the Di-
14 rector of the Secret Service shall submit to the Commit-
15 tees on Appropriations of the House of Representatives
16 and the Senate, the Committee on Homeland Security and
17 the Committee on Oversight and Government Reform of
18 the House of Representatives, and the Committee on
19 Homeland Security and Governmental Affairs of the Sen-
20 ate a report on the effects of the amendments made by
21 subsection (a). The report shall include, with respect to
22 the previous calendar year, the information described
23 under paragraphs (1) through (7) of section 2(c) of Public
24 Law 115–160.

Amend the title so as to read: “A bill to amend the
Overtime Pay for Protective Services Act of 2016 to ex-

tend the Secret Service overtime pay exception through 2020, and for other purposes.”.
