

Suspend the Rules and Pass the Bill, H.R. 1593, With an Amendment

(The amendment strikes all after the enacting clause and inserts a new text)

To amend the Homeland Security Act of 2002 to establish a school security coordinating council, and for other purposes.

Mr. PAYNE (for himself, Mr. THOMPSON of Mississippi, and Mr. GREEN of Texas) introduced the following bill; which was referred to the Committee on Homeland Security

A BILL

To amend the Homeland Security Act of 2002 to establish a school security coordinating council, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Coordinating and
5 Leveraging Activities for School Security Act” or the
6 “CLASS Act of 2019”.

1 **SEC. 2. SCHOOL SECURITY COORDINATING COUNCIL.**

2 (a) IN GENERAL.—Title VII of the Homeland Secu-
3 rity Act of 2002 (6 U.S.C. 341 et seq.) is amended by
4 adding at the end the following new section:

5 **“SEC. 711. SCHOOL SECURITY COORDINATING COUNCIL.**

6 “(a) ESTABLISHMENT.—There is established in the
7 Department a coordinating council to ensure that, to the
8 maximum extent practicable, activities, plans, and policies
9 to enhance the security of an early childhood education
10 program, elementary school, high school, or secondary
11 schools against an act of terrorism are coordinated.

12 “(b) COMPOSITION.—The members of the council es-
13 tablished pursuant to subsection (a) shall include the fol-
14 lowing:

15 “(1) The Under Secretary for Strategy, Policy,
16 and Plans.

17 “(2) The Director of the Cybersecurity and In-
18 frastructure Security.

19 “(3) The Administrator of the Federal Emer-
20 gency Management Agency.

21 “(4) The Director of the Secret Service.

22 “(5) The Executive Director of the Office of
23 Academic Engagement.

24 “(6) The Assistant Secretary for Public Affairs.

25 “(7) Any other official of the Department the
26 Secretary determines appropriate.

1 “(c) LEADERSHIP.—The Secretary shall designate a
2 member of the council to serve as chair of the council.

3 “(d) REPORTS.—Not later than January 30, 2021,
4 and annually thereafter, the Secretary shall submit to the
5 Committee on Homeland Security of the House of Rep-
6 resentatives and the Committee on Homeland Security
7 and Governmental Affairs of the Senate a report regard-
8 ing the council’s activities during the preceding year, in-
9 cluding information on any metrics regarding the efficacy
10 of such activities and any engagement with stakeholders
11 outside of the Federal Government.

12 “(e) DEFINITIONS.—In this section, the terms ‘early
13 childhood education program’, ‘elementary school’, ‘high
14 school’, and ‘secondary school’ have the meanings given
15 such terms in section 8101 of the Elementary and Sec-
16 ondary Education Act of 1965 (20 U.S.C. 7801).”.

17 (b) CLERICAL AMENDMENT.—The table of contents
18 in section 1(b) of the Homeland Security Act of 2002 is
19 amended by inserting after the item relating to section
20 710 the following new item:

“Sec. 711. School security coordinating council.”.
