To reauthorize the Bulletproof Vest Partnership Grant Program.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. BULLETPROOF VEST PARTNERSHIP GRANT**
4 **PROGRAM REAUTHORIZATION.**

5 (a) IN GENERAL.—Section 1001(a)(23) of title I of
6 the Omnibus Crime Control and Safe Streets Act of 1968
7 (34 U.S.C. 10261(a)(23)) is amended by striking “part
8 Y” and all that follows and inserting “part Y,

1 \$30,000,000 for fiscal year 2020, and each fiscal year
2 thereafter.”.

3 (b) PROGRAM NAME.—Part Y of title I of the Omni-
4 bus Crime Control and Safe Streets Act of 1968 (34
5 U.S.C. 10531 et seq.) is amended by inserting before sec-
6 tion 2501 the following:

7 **“SEC. 2500. PATRICK LEAHY BULLETPROOF VEST PART-**
8 **nership Grant Program.**

9 “The program under this part shall be known as the
10 ‘Patrick Leahy Bulletproof Vest Partnership Grant Pro-
11 gram’.”.
