A BILL

To authorize the Every Word We Utter Monument to establish a commemorative work in the District of Columbia and its environs, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. AUTHORIZATION TO ESTABLISH COMMEMORA-**
4 **TIVE WORK.**

5 (a) IN GENERAL.—The Every Word We Utter Monu-
6 ment may establish a commemorative work on Federal

1 land in the District of Columbia and its environs to com-
2 memorate the women’s suffrage movement and the pas-
3 sage of the 19th Amendment to the Constitution, which
4 gave women the right to vote.

5 (b) COMPLIANCE WITH STANDARDS FOR COMMEMO-
6 RATIVE WORKS.—The establishment of the commemora-
7 tive work under this section shall be in accordance with
8 chapter 89 of title 40, United States Code (commonly
9 known as the “Commemorative Works Act”).

10 (c) PROHIBITION ON THE USE OF FEDERAL
11 FUNDS.—

12 (1) IN GENERAL.—Federal funds may not be
13 used to pay any expense of the establishment of the
14 commemorative work under this section.

15 (2) RESPONSIBILITY OF THE EVERY WORD WE
16 UTTER MONUMENT.—The Every Word We Utter
17 Monument shall be solely responsible for acceptance
18 of contributions for, and payment of the expenses of,
19 the establishment of the commemorative work under
20 this section.

21 (d) DEPOSIT OF EXCESS FUNDS.—

22 (1) IN GENERAL.—If upon payment of all ex-
23 penses for the establishment of the memorial (in-
24 cluding the maintenance and preservation amount
25 required by section 8906(b)(1) of title 40, United

1 States Code), there remains a balance of funds re-
2 ceived for the establishment of the commemorative
3 work, the Every Word We Utter Monument shall
4 transmit the amount of the balance to the Secretary
5 of the Interior for deposit in the account provided
6 for in section 8906(b)(3) of title 40, United States
7 Code.

8 (2) ON EXPIRATION OF AUTHORITY.—If upon
9 expiration of the authority for the commemorative
10 work under section 8903(e) of title 40, United
11 States Code, there remains a balance of funds re-
12 ceived for the establishment of the commemorative
13 work, the Every Word We Utter Monument shall
14 transmit the amount of the balance to a separate ac-
15 count with the National Park Foundation for memo-
16 rials, to be available to the Secretary of the Interior
17 or Administrator (as appropriate) following the proc-
18 ess provided in section 8906(b)(4) of title 40, United
19 States Code, for accounts established under
20 8906(b)(2) or (3) of title 40, United States Code.

21 **SEC. 2. DETERMINATION OF BUDGETARY EFFECTS.**

22 The budgetary effects of this Act, for the purpose of
23 complying with the Statutory Pay-As-You-Go Act of 2010,
24 shall be determined by reference to the latest statement
25 titled “Budgetary Effects of PAYGO Legislation” for this

1 Act, submitted for printing in the Congressional Record
2 by the Chairman of the House Budget Committee, pro-
3 vided that such statement has been submitted prior to the
4 vote on passage.
