## A BILL

To direct the Secretary of Veterans Affairs to carry out a Native VetSuccess at Tribal Colleges and Universities Pilot Program.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
- 4 This Act may be cited as the "Native VetSuccess at
- 5 Tribal Colleges and Universities Pilot Program Act".

| 1  | SEC. 2. NATIVE VETSUCCESS AT TRIBAL COLLEGES AND            |
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| 2  | UNIVERSITIES PILOT PROGRAM.                                 |
| 3  | (a) In General.—Not later than 18 months after              |
| 4  | the date of the enactment of this Act, the Secretary of     |
| 5  | Veterans Affairs shall carry out a five-year pilot program, |
| 6  | to be known as the "Native VetSuccess at Tribal Colleges    |
| 7  | and Universities Pilot Program". Under such pilot pro-      |
| 8  | gram the Secretary shall—                                   |
| 9  | (1) identify three regional Native VetSuccess               |
| 10 | service areas consisting of at least two participating      |
| 11 | Tribal colleges or universities;                            |
| 12 | (2) assign to each regional Native VetSuccess               |
| 13 | service area a VetSuccess on Campus counselor and           |
| 14 | a full-time Vet Center outreach coordinator, both of        |
| 15 | whom shall be based on one or more of the partici-          |
| 16 | pating Tribal colleges or universities in the service       |
| 17 | area; and   |
| 18 | (3) provide for eligible students at such partici-          |
| 19 | pating colleges and universities with all services for      |
| 20 | which such students would be eligible under the             |
| 21 | VetSuccess on Campus program of the Department              |
| 22 | of Veterans Affairs.  |
| 23 | (b) ELIGIBLE STUDENTS.—For purposes of the pilot            |
| 24 | program, an eligible student is a student who is a veteran, |
| 25 | member of the Armed Forces, or dependent of a veteran       |
| 26 | or member of the Armed Forces who is eligible for any       |

| 3  | (c) Consultation Requirement.—In developing                 |
| 4  | the pilot program under this section, the Secretary, acting |
| 5  | through the Veteran Readiness and Employment Program        |
| 6  | of the Department of Veterans Affairs and in coordination   |
| 7  | with the Office of Tribal Government Relations of the De-   |
| 8  | partment, shall consult with Indian tribes, Tribal organi-  |
| 9  | zations, and veterans service organizations regarding each  |
| 10 | of the following:   |
| 11 | (1) The design of the pilot program.                        |
| 12 | (2) The selection of the three regional Native              |
| 13 | VetSuccess service areas and participating Tribal           |
| 14 | colleges and universities, taking into consideration—       |
| 15 | (A) the number of eligible students en-                     |
| 16 | rolled in the college or university and in the re-          |
| 17 | gional service area;  |
| 18 | (B) the capacity of the colleges and univer-                |
| 19 | sities in the regional service area to accommo-             |
| 20 | date a full-time VetSuccess on Campus coun-                 |
| 21 | selor and a full-time Vet Center outreach coor-             |
| 22 | dinator;  |
| 23 | (C) the lack of information available at the                |
| 24 | colleges and universities in the regional service           |
| 25 | area about and lack of access to benefits and               |

| 8  | at Tribal colleges and universities.                         |
| 9  | (d) Outreach to Colleges and Universities.—                  |
| 10 | The Secretary shall provide notice of the pilot program      |
| 11 | to all Tribal colleges and universities and encourage all    |
| 12 | Tribal colleges and universities to coordinate with each     |
| 13 | other to create regional service areas to participate in the |
| 14 | pilot program.   |
| 15 | (e) Briefings and Reports.—                                  |
| 16 | (1) Implementation briefing.—Not later                       |
| 17 | than one year after the date of the enactment of this        |
| 18 | Act, the Secretary shall provide for the Committee           |
| 19 | on Veterans' Affairs and the Committee on Natural            |
| 20 | Resources of the House of Representatives and the            |
| 21 | Committee on Veterans' Affairs and the Committee             |
| 22 | on Indian Affairs of the Senate a briefing on—               |
| 23 | (A) the design, structure, and objectives of                 |
| 24 | the pilot program: and                                       |

| 16 | (C) The graduation rate of eligible stu-              |
| 17 | dents who received services through the pilot         |

| 20 | year of graduation for eligible students who re-      |
| 21 | ceived services through the pilot program.            |
| 22 | (E) Feedback from each Tribal college or              |
| 23 | university that participated in the pilot pro-        |
| 24 | gram, including on the regional nature of the         |
| 25 | program.  |

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| 2  | a regionally based Native VetSuccess at Tribal         |
