A BILL

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. REPEAL OF JOINT RESOLUTION TO PROMOTE**
4 **PEACE AND STABILITY IN THE MIDDLE EAST.**

5 Effective on the date that is 90 days after the date
6 of the enactment of this Act, the joint resolution entitled
