To amend title 38, United States Code, to extend and modify certain authorities and requirements relating to the Department of Veterans Affairs, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Department of Vet-
5 erans Affairs Expiring Authorities Act of 2021”.

1 **SEC. 2. EXTENSION OF AUTHORITY FOR DENTAL INSUR-**
2 **ANCE PLAN FOR VETERANS AND SURVIVORS**
3 **AND DEPENDENTS OF VETERANS.**

4 Section 1712C of title 38, United States Code, is
5 amended by striking subsection (j).

6 **SEC. 3. EXTENSION OF TEMPORARY EXPANSION OF PAY-**
7 **MENTS AND ALLOWANCES FOR BENEFICIARY**
8 **TRAVEL IN CONNECTION WITH VETERANS**
9 **RECEIVING CARE FROM VET CENTERS.**

10 Section 104(a) of the Honoring America's Veterans
11 and Caring for Camp Lejeune Families Act of 2012 (Pub-
12 lic Law 112–154; 126 Stat. 1169), as most recently
13 amended by section 5109 of the Continuing Appropria-
14 tions Act, 2021 and Other Extensions Act (Public Law
15 116–159; 134 Stat. 749), is further amended by striking
16 “September 30, 2021” and inserting “September 30,
17 2022”.

18 **SEC. 4. EXTENSION OF AUTHORITY FOR PILOT PROGRAM**
19 **ON ACCEPTANCE BY THE DEPARTMENT OF**
20 **VETERANS AFFAIRS OF DONATED FACILITIES**
21 **AND RELATED IMPROVEMENTS.**

22 Section 2(i) of the Communities Helping Invest
23 through Property and Improvements Needed for Veterans
24 Act of 2016 (Public Law 114–294; 38 U.S.C. 8103 note)
25 is amended by striking “the date that is 5 years after the

1 date of the enactment of this Act” and inserting “Decem-
2 ber 16, 2026”.

3 **SEC. 5. DETERMINATION OF BUDGETARY EFFECTS.**

4 The budgetary effects of this Act, for the purpose of
5 complying with the Statutory Pay-As-You-Go Act of 2010,
6 shall be determined by reference to the latest statement
7 titled “Budgetary Effects of PAYGO Legislation” for this
8 Act, submitted for printing in the Congressional Record
9 by the Chairman of the House Budget Committee, pro-
10 vided that such statement has been submitted prior to the
11 vote on passage.
