A BILL

To direct the Secretary of Veterans Affairs to submit to Congress periodic reports on the costs of the Department of Veterans Affairs Electronic Health Record Modernization program.

1	Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
2	tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
3	SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
4	This Act may be cited as the "VA Electronic Health
5	Record Transparency Act of 2021".
6	SEC. 2. REPORTS ON COSTS, PERFORMANCE METRICS, AND
7	OUTCOMES OF DEPARTMENT OF VETERANS
8	AFFAIRS ELECTRONIC HEALTH RECORD MOD-
9	ERNIZATION PROGRAM.
10	(a) In General.—Section 503 of the Veterans Benefits
11	and Transition Act of 2018 (Public Law 115–407; 38
12	U.S.C. 5701 note prec.) is amended—
13	(1) by redesignating subsection (e) as subsection
14	(f);
15	(2) by inserting after subsection (d) the following
16	new subsection (e):
17	"(e) Quarterly Reports.—
18	"(1) Reports on costs of ehrm program.—
19	Not later than 90 days after the date of the enactment
20	of the VA Electronic Health Record Transparency Act
21	of 2021, and every 30 days after the last day of each
22	fiscal quarter thereafter until the termination date
23	specified in paragraph (3), the Secretary of Veterans
24	Affairs shall submit to the Committees on Veterans'
25	Affairs of the Senate and House of Representatives a

1	report on the costs of the Electronic Health Record
2	Modernization program of the Department of Vet-
3	erans Affairs. Each such report shall include, for the
4	period covered by the report and for the total period
5	beginning on the date of the enactment of the VA
6	Electronic Health Record Transparency Act of 2021
7	and ending on the date of the submittal of the report,
8	a description of all actual expenses of, and driven by,
9	such program, including any such expenses paid
10	using—
11	"(A) any funds appropriated for the De-
12	partment of Veterans Affairs, for any source or
13	account, expended by any organizational element
14	of the Department or by the Federal Electronic
15	Health Record Modernization Office for the Elec-
16	$tronic\ Health\ Record\ Modernization\ Program;$
17	"(B) any funds, from any source or ac-
18	count, expended by any organizational element
19	of the Department for physical or technology in-
20	frastructure modifications, enhancements, im-
21	provements, or expansions at a facility of the
22	Department necessitated by, or related or per-
23	taining to, the Electronic Health Record Mod-
24	ernization Program; and

1	"(C) any funds, from any source or ac-
2	count, expended by any organizational element
3	of the Department or by the Federal Electronic
4	Health Record Modernization Office for consult-
5	ants, support contractors, or experts related or
6	pertaining to the Electronic Health Record Mod-
7	ernization Program.
8	"(2) Reports on Performance metrics and
9	OUTCOMES.—Not later than 90 days after the date of
10	the enactment of the VA Electronic Health Record
11	Transparency Act of 2021, and every 30 days after
12	the last day of each fiscal quarter thereafter until the
13	termination date specified in paragraph (3), the Sec-
14	retary of Veterans Affairs shall submit to the Com-
15	mittees on Veterans' Affairs of the Senate and House
16	of Representatives a report on the performance
17	metrics and outcomes of the Electronic Health Record
18	Modernization Program. Each such report shall in-
19	clude, for the period covered by the report—
20	"(A) a list of the quality, performance, safe-
21	ty, or value metrics, key performance indicators,
22	and other diagnostic or evaluation criteria in
23	use to assess the Electronic Health Record Mod-
24	ernization Program and the electronic health
25	record system, in general and at individual fa-

1	cilities, with respect to veterans, employees of the
2	Department, and Departmental operations;
3	"(B) an explanation of any change to any
4	of such metrics, indicators, and criteria com-
5	pared to the metrics, indicators, and criteria in-
6	cluded in any previous report submitted under
7	this paragraph;
8	"(C) the data supporting or demonstrating
9	each such metric, indicator, and criteria com-
10	pared to the data supporting or demonstrating
11	such metric, indicator, or criteria as included in
12	the previous report submitted under this para-
13	graph; and
14	"(D) a list of patient safety reports, inci-
15	dents, alerts, or disclosures at each facility of the
16	Department where the electronic health record
17	system has been implemented.
18	"(3) Termination date.—The requirement to
19	submit a report under paragraph (1) shall terminate
20	on the date that is 90 days after the date on which
21	the Secretary submits to the Committees on Veterans'
22	Affairs of the Senate and House of Representatives
23	certification that the Electronic Health Record Mod-
24	ernization program has been fully implemented.";

1	(3) in subsection (f), as redesignated by para-
2	graph (1), by adding at the end the following new
3	paragraphs:
4	"(3) The term 'electronic health record system'
5	means the electronic health record system imple-
6	mented pursuant to the Electronic Health Record
7	Modernization Program.
8	"(4) The term 'Federal Electronic Health Record
9	Management Office' means the office established under
10	section 1635(b) of the Wounded Warrior Act (title
11	XVI of Public Law 110–181; 10 U.S.C. 1071 note).
12	"(5) The term 'facility of the Department' in-
13	cludes a joint facility of the Department of Veterans
14	Affairs and the Department of Defense.".

Amend the title so as to read: "A bill to direct the Secretary of Veterans Affairs to submit to Congress periodic reports on the costs, performance metrics, and outcomes of the Department of Veterans Affairs Electronic Health Record Modernization program.".
