A BILL

To amend title 38, United States Code, to establish protections for a member of the Armed Forces who leaves a course of education, paid for with certain educational assistance, to perform certain service.

4	This Act may be cited as the "Protections for Student
5	Veterans Act".

sued at a public institution of higher
learning in which the public institu-
tion of higher learning enters into a
contract or agreement with an entity
(other than another public institution
of higher learning) to provide such pro-
gram of education or a portion of such
program of education.".
(e) APPLICATION.—
(1) In GENERAL.—Except as provided by para-
graph (2), the amendments made by this section shall
apply with respect to a quarter, semester, or term, as
applicable, commencing on or after the date of the en-
actment of this Act.
(2) Special rule for current students.—
In the case of an individual who, as of the date of the
enactment of this Act, is using educational assistance

1	under chapter 33 of title 38, United States Code, to
2	pursue a course of education that includes a program
3	of education described in item (bb) or (cc) of section
4	3313(c)(1)(A)(ii)(II) of title 38, United States Code,
5	as added by subsections (c) and (d), respectively, the

7	respect to a quarter, semester, or term, as applicable,
8	commencing on or after the date that is two years
9	after the date of the enactment of this Act.
