#### 1 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.

2 This Act may be cited as the "Advancing Uniform
3 Transportation Opportunities for Veterans Act" or the
4 "AUTO for Veterans Act".

5 SEC. 2. ELIGIBILITY FOR DEPARTMENT OF VETERANS AF6 FAIRS PROVISION OF ADDITIONAL AUTO7 MOBILE OR OTHER ADAPTED EQUIPMENT.

8 Section 3903(a) of title 38, United States Code, is9 amended—

(1) in paragraph (1), by striking "paragraph
(2)" and inserting "paragraphs (2) and (3)"; and
