A BILL

To amend the Public Health Service Act to expand the allowable use criteria for new access points grants for community health centers.

1	Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
2	tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
3	SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
4	This Act may be cited as the "Maximizing Outcomes
5	through Better Investments in Lifesaving Equipment for
6	(MOBILE) Health Care Act".
7	SEC. 2. NEW ACCESS POINTS GRANTS.
8	(a) In General.—Section 330(e)(6)(A) of the Public
9	Health Service Act (42 U.S.C. 254b(e)(6)(A)) is amended
10	by adding at the end the following:
11	"(v) Mobile units.—An existing
12	health center may be awarded funds under
13	clause (i) to establish a new delivery site
14	that is a mobile unit, regardless of whether
15	the applicant additionally proposes to es-
16	tablish a permanent, full-time site. In the
17	case of a health center that is not currently
18	receiving funds under this section, such
19	health center may be awarded funds under
20	clause (i) to establish a new delivery site
21	that is a mobile unit only if such health
22	center uses a portion of such funds to also
23	establish a permanent, full-time site.".
24	(b) Effective Date.—The amendment made by sub-
25	section (a) shall take effect on January 1, 2024.
