S. 198

AN ACT

To require the Federal Communications Commission to incorporate data on maternal health outcomes into its broadband health maps.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Data Mapping to Save
5 Moms’ Lives Act”.

6 **SEC. 2. MAPPING BROADBAND CONNECTIVITY AND MATER-**
7 **NAL HEALTH OUTCOMES.**

8 (a) INCORPORATION OF MATERNAL MORTALITY AND
9 SEVERE MATERNAL MORBIDITY DATA.—Not later than
10 180 days after the date of the enactment of this Act, the
11 Federal Communications Commission shall incorporate
12 publicly available data on maternal mortality and severe
13 maternal morbidity, including for not less than 1 year

1 postpartum, into the Mapping Broadband Health in
2 America platform of the Commission.

3 (b) CONSULTATION WITH CDC.—The Federal Com-
4 munications Commission shall consult with the Director
5 of the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention regard-
6 ing the maternal mortality and severe maternal morbidity
7 data that should be incorporated under subsection (a).
