to be proposed by Mr. SCHATZ

Viz:

1 Strike all after the enacting clause and insert the fol-  
2 lowing:

3 **SECTION 1. EXTENSION OF, AND ADDITIONAL SUPPORT**  
4 **FOR THE ACTIVITIES OF, THE DEPARTMENT**  
5 **OF THE INTERIOR AND THE DEPARTMENT OF**  
6 **JUSTICE JOINT COMMISSION ON REDUCING**  
7 **VIOLENT CRIME AGAINST INDIANS.**

8 (a) EXTENSION OF COMMISSION AND ACTIVITIES OF  
9 THE COMMISSION.—Section 4 of the Not Invisible Act of  
10 2019 (Public Law 116–166; 134 Stat. 767) is amended—

1           (1) in subsection (c)(2)(B), by striking “18  
2           months after the enactment” and inserting “36  
3           months after the date of enactment”; and

4           (2) in subsection (e), by striking “2 years” and  
5           inserting “42 months”.

6           (b) ADDITIONAL SUPPORT FOR ACTIVITIES OF COM-  
7           MISSION.—Section 4(b) of the Not Invisible Act of 2019  
8           (Public Law 116–166; 134 Stat. 767) is amended—

9           (1) in the subsection heading, by inserting “;  
10          OPERATION” after “MEMBERSHIP”; and

11          (2) by adding at the end the following:

12          “(7) GIFTS.—The Commission may accept and  
13          use gifts or donations of services or property from  
14          Indian tribes or Tribal entities, academic institu-  
15          tions, or other not-for-profit organizations as it con-  
16          siders necessary to carry out the duties of the Com-  
17          mission described in subsection (e).”.
