## A BILL

To extend the authorization of the Chemical Facility Anti-Terrorism Standards Program of the Department of Homeland Security.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Protecting and Secur-  
5 ing Chemical Facilities from Terrorist Attacks Act of  
6 2023”.

1 **SEC. 2. EXTENSION OF AUTHORIZATION OF CHEMICAL FA-**  
2 **CILITY ANTI-TERRORISM STANDARDS PRO-**  
3 **GRAM OF THE DEPARTMENT OF HOMELAND**  
4 **SECURITY.**

5 Section 5 of the Protecting and Securing Chemical  
6 Facilities from Terrorist Attacks Act of 2014 (Public Law  
7 113–254; 6 U.S.C. 621 note) is amended by striking  
8 “2023” and inserting “2025”.
