A BILL

To amend the Federal Lands Recreation Enhancement Act to provide for lifetime National Parks and Federal Recreational Lands Passes for family members of members of the Armed Forces who lost their lives while serving their country.

1	Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
2	tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
3	SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
4	This Act may be cited as the "Military Families Na-
5	tional Parks Access Enhancement Act".
6	SEC. 2. LIFETIME PASSES.
7	Section 805(b)(2) of the Federal Lands Recreation En-
8	hancement Act (16 U.S.C. 6804(b)(2)) is amended by add-
9	ing at the end the following:
10	"(D) Any individual who is a survivor enti-
11	tled to—
12	"(i) a death gratuity under section
13	1475 of title 10, United States Code; or
14	"(ii) dependency and indemnity com-
15	pensation under chapter 13 of title 38,
16	United States Code.".
