RESOLUTION

Providing for consideration of the bill (H.R. 27) to amend the Controlled Substances Act with respect to the scheduling of fentanyl-related substances, and for other purposes.

1 *Resolved*, That upon adoption of this resolution it
2 shall be in order to consider in the House the bill (H.R.
3 27) to amend the Controlled Substances Act with respect
4 to the scheduling of fentanyl-related substances, and for
5 other purposes. All points of order against consideration
6 of the bill are waived. The amendment printed in part A

1 of the report of the Committee on Rules accompanying
2 this resolution shall be considered as adopted. The bill,
3 as amended, shall be considered as read. All points of
4 order against provisions in the bill, as amended, are
5 waived. The previous question shall be considered as or-
6 dered on the bill, as amended, and on any further amend-
7 ment thereto, to final passage without intervening motion
8 except: (1) one hour of debate equally divided and con-
9 trolled by the chair and ranking minority member of the
10 Committee on Energy and Commerce or their respective
11 designees; (2) the further amendment printed in part B
12 of the report of the Committee on Rules, if offered by the
13 Member designated in the report, which shall be in order
14 without intervention of any point of order, shall be consid-
15 ered as read, shall be separately debatable for the time
16 specified in the report equally divided and controlled by
17 the proponent and an opponent, and shall not be subject
18 to a demand for division of the question; and (3) one mo-
19 tion to recommit.
