## A BILL

To direct the Secretary of Commerce, acting through the Assistant Secretary of Commerce for Communications and Information, to conduct a study of the national security risks posed by consumer routers, modems, and devices that combine a modem and router, and for other purposes.

- 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
- 4 This Act may be cited as the "Removing Our Unsecure
- 5 Technologies to Ensure Reliability and Security Act" or the
- 6 "ROUTERS Act".
- 7 SEC. 2. STUDY OF RISKS POSED BY CERTAIN ROUTERS AND
- 8 MODEMS.
- 9 (a) In General.—The Secretary shall conduct a
- 10 study of the national security risks and cybersecurity
- 11 vulnerabilities posed by consumer routers, modems, and de-
- 12 vices that combine a modem and router that are designed,
- 13 developed, manufactured, or supplied by persons owned by,
- 14 controlled by, or subject to the influence of a covered coun-
- 15 *try*.
- 16 (b) Report to Congress.—Not later than 1 year
- 17 after the date of the enactment of this Act, the Secretary
- 18 shall submit to the Committee on Energy and Commerce
- 19 of the House of Representatives and the Committee on Com-
- 20 merce, Science, and Transportation of the Senate a report
- 21 on the results of the study conducted under subsection (a).
- 22 (c) Consultation Within Department.—In con-
- 23 ducting the study under subsection (a), the Secretary shall
- 24 consult with appropriate bureaus and offices within the De-
- 25 partment of Commerce.
