## A BILL

To amend title 40, United States Code, to limit the construction of new courthouses under certain circumstances, and for other purposes.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
- 4 This Act may be cited as the "Courthouse Afford-
- 5 ability and Space Efficiency Act of 2025" or the "CASE
- 6 Act".

1	SEC. 2. REDUCING COSTS RELATED TO COURTHOUSES.
2	(a) In General.—Chapter 33 of title 40, United
3	States Code, as amended by this act, is further amended
4	by adding at the end the following:
5	" $\S$ 3320. Reducing costs related to courthouses
6	"(a) Limitation on New Courthouses.—The Ad-
7	ministrator of General Services may not commence con-
8	struction of any new courthouse if—
9	"(1) construction has not begun on or before
10	the date of enactment of this section; or
11	"(2) the design and construction of the new
12	courthouse fails to comply, at a minimum, with the
13	courtroom sharing requirements described in sub-
14	section (b).
15	"(b) Courtroom Sharing Requirements De-
16	FINED.—The term 'courtroom sharing requirements'
17	means—
18	"(1) in courthouses with 10 or more active dis-
19	trict judges, 2 courtrooms per 3 active district
20	judges, except such courthouses may contain not less
21	than 9 courtrooms for active district judges;
22	"(2) in courthouses with 3 or more bankruptcy
23	judges—
24	"(A) 1 courtroom per 2 bankruptcy judges;
25	"(B) 1 courtroom for emergency matters;
26	and

1	"(C) if there is an odd number of bank-
2	ruptcy judges, the number of courtrooms re-
3	quired pursuant to subparagraph (A) shall be
4	rounded down;
5	"(3) in courthouses with 3 or more senior dis-
6	trict judges, 1 courtroom per 2 senior district
7	judges; and
8	"(4) in courthouses with 3 or more magistrate
9	judges—
10	"(A) 1 courtroom per 2 magistrate judges;
11	"(B) 1 criminal duty courtroom; and
12	"(C) if there is an odd number of mag-
13	istrate judges, the number of courtrooms re-
14	quired pursuant to subparagraph (A) shall be
15	rounded down.
16	"(c) United States Courts Design Guide.—Not
17	later than 180 days after the date of enactment of this
18	section, the Design Guide for courthouses shall be updated
19	to incorporate courtroom sharing requirements to the
20	maximum extent practicable.
21	"(d) UTILIZATION.—If a new courthouse will add ca-
22	pacity in the inventory of the General Services Adminis-
23	tration, existing space in the same courthouse complex
24	must be fully utilized or relinquished from the inventory
25	of the General Services Administration.".
