Mr. BEGICH introduced the following bill; which was referred to the Committee on Natural Resources

A BILL

To amend the John D. Dingell, Jr. Conservation, Management, and Recreation Act to reauthorize the National Volcano Early Warning and Monitoring System.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. NATIONAL VOLCANO EARLY WARNING AND**
4 **MONITORING SYSTEM REAUTHORIZATION.**

5 Section 5001(c) of the John D. Dingell, Jr. Conserva-
6 tion, Management, and Recreation Act (43 U.S.C. 31k(c))
7 is amended—

1 (1) in paragraph (1)—

2 (A) by striking “United States Geological
3 Survey” and inserting “Secretary”; and

4 (B) by striking “2019 through 2023” and
5 inserting “2026 through 2029”; and

6 (2) in paragraph (2)—

7 (A) by striking “National Oceanic and At-
8 mospheric Administration” and inserting “Sec-
9 retary of Commerce”; and

10 (B) by striking “such sums as may be nec-
11 essary for the period of fiscal years 2023
12 through 2024” and inserting “\$470,000 for
13 each of fiscal years 2026 through 2029”.
