

Amendment Offered by Mrs. Cammack of Florida

Brief Summary

North Florida is home to new peanut growers who have been left out of current base acreage arrangements. This amendment would

- Create flexibility by allowing voluntary base acreage updates for commodities for farms based on average acres planted during crop years 2016-2020.

**AMENDMENT TO THE COMMITTEE PRINT
OFFERED BY MRS. CAMMACK OF FLORIDA**

At the end of the committee print, add the following:

1 **SEC. 14002. VOLUNTARY UPDATE FOR AVERAGE ACRES**
2 **PLANTED DURING CROP YEAR 2016-2020.**

3 Section 1112 of the Agricultural Act of 2014 (7
4 U.S.C. 9012) is amended by adding at the end the fol-
5 lowing:

6 “(e) VOLUNTARY UPDATE FOR AVERAGE ACRES
7 PLANTED DURING CROP YEAR 2016-2020.—As soon as
8 practicable after the date of the enactment of this sub-
9 section, the Secretary shall provide notice to the owners
10 of a farm regarding their opportunity, beginning with crop
11 year 2022, to update the base acres for commodities for
12 such farm to reflect the average acres planted to covered
13 commodities during crop years 2016 through 2020.”.
