Scott Blubaugh is the president of Oklahoma Farmers Union Cooperative, a farm organization representing farmers, ranchers and rural citizens. In addition to his position with OFU, Blubaugh operates a diversified 3,500-acre family farm and ranch.

As president of Oklahoma Farmers Union, Blubaugh leads the organization in all legislative efforts. These efforts vary in scope, from helping individual OFU members navigate local political concerns to representing OFU's grassroots, member-developed policy on the regional and national stage. Blubaugh also manages a full roster of rural education and agricultural programs and serves as a spokesman for rural issues.

Blubaugh is a graduate of the Oklahoma Ag Leadership Program. In addition to his position with OFU, he also serves National Farmers Union as a member of the NFU Executive Board of Directors and chair of the NFU Education Committee. He has also served as an agricultural and rural community advisor for U.S. Congressman Richard Gephardt of Missouri and is a founding member and President of the Oklahoma Certified Beef Association.

Blubaugh and his wife Lisa own a rural insurance agency and manage the family farming operation, which stretches across three counties in northern Oklahoma. In conjunction with the farming operation, the Blubaughs host the annual Blubaugh Angus Ranch registered Angus production sale.

Blubaugh is a fifth-generation farmer and rancher and a lifelong resident of Kay County, Oklahoma. He currently resides on his family ranch near Tonkawa. He and Lisa have been married 32 years; they have two sons, Zachary and Zane.
