

**Amendment offered by Rep. Andrea Salinas**

**Amendment description**

The amendment would require all revenue generated by timber sales be utilized for hiring and paying wildland firefighters and forest management personnel.

**AMENDMENT**  
**OFFERED BY MS. SALINAS OF OREGON**

At the end of section 10105, add the following:

1       (e) **TIMBER SALES SALARIES AND EXPENSES.**—Title  
2 I of the Healthy Forests Restoration Act of 2003 (16  
3 U.S.C. 6511 et seq.) is amended by adding at the end  
4 the following:

5       **“SEC. 109. TIMBER SALES SALARIES AND EXPENSES.**

6       “(a) **IN GENERAL.**—Any funds received from the sale  
7 of timber under a covered provision shall be used for sala-  
8 ries and expenses to carry out—

9               “(1) activities authorized by this title;

10              “(2) activities related to National Forest Sys-  
11 tem restoration and management; and

12              “(3) wildland firefighting.

13       “(b) **COVERED PROVISION.**—In this section, the term  
14 ‘covered provision’ means any of the following:

15              “(1) Section 14 of the National Forest Manage-  
16 ment Act of 1976 (16 U.S.C. 472a) (timber sales on  
17 national forest system lands).

18              “(2) Section 8206 of the Agricultural Act of  
19 2014 (16 U.S.C. 2113a) (good neighbor authority).

1                   “(3) Section 604 of this Act (16 U.S.C. 6591c)  
2                   (stewardship end result contracting projects).”.
