**Amendment Description:**

This amendment requires the President to provide Congress and the public with certain information at least 30 days before issuing an executive order related to agriculture, food, and the livelihood of farmers, ranchers, and producers in the United States.

Add at the end the following:

1 **SEC. \_\_\_\_.** **NOTIFICATION RESPECTING CERTAIN EXECU-**  
2 **TIVE ORDERS.**

3 (a) IN GENERAL.—Not later than 30 days before  
4 issuing a qualifying executive order, the President shall  
5 transmit to the Congress, and make publicly available, a  
6 notification with respect to such executive order. Such no-  
7 tification shall contain—

8 (1) the text of the executive order;

9 (2) the Federal law or laws affected by the ex-  
10 ecutive order that is the subject of the notification;

11 (3) how the President is working within the pa-  
12 rameters specified in Federal law and the Constitu-  
13 tion;

14 (4) the means by which the executive order will  
15 be accomplished, including through any related Fed-  
16 eral agencies or departments; and

17 (5) a comprehensive list of organizations, busi-  
18 nesses, and other parties or entities the President,  
19 or the President’s designee, engaged with prior to  
20 the issuance of such executive order.

1       (b) REPORTS.—Not later than 6 months after the  
2 date of the enactment of this Act, and every 12 months  
3 thereafter, the President shall submit to the Congress a  
4 report on the outcome of each qualifying executive order  
5 issued during the period covered by the report.

6       (c) QUALIFYING EXECUTIVE ORDER.—In this sec-  
7 tion, the term “qualifying executive order” means any ex-  
8 ecutive order (including an executive order that revokes  
9 or nullifies a previous executive order) issued after the  
10 date of the enactment of this Act that relates to agri-  
11 culture, food, and the livelihood of farmers, ranchers, and  
12 producers in the United States.
