REVISED INTERIM SUBALLOCATION OF BUDGET ALLOCATIONS FOR FISCAL YEAR 2018

The Committee on Appropriations submits the following report on the interim revised suballocation of budget allocations for fiscal year 2018.

In order to continue developing the 12 fiscal year 2018 appropriations bills, the Committee is providing interim 302(b) suballocations to the remaining 11 subcommittees in order to facilitate their consideration by the House as soon as possible. To date, the Committee has reported three appropriations bills to the House.

The Committee continues to adopt such interim allocations given a concurrent resolution for the budget for fiscal year 2018 has yet to be adopted.
