Description of Motion: To prohibit the use of federal funds to implement: (1) U.S. Citizenship and Immigration Services Policy Memo 602-0162; (2) The memorandum from the Principal Legal Advisor on Litigating Domestic Violence-Based Persecution Claims Following Matter of A-B-; (3) Executive Order 13780; (4) Presidential Proclamation 9645; (5) Executive Order 13815; (6) The proposed rule by the Department of Homeland Security entitled "Inadmissibility on Public Charge Grounds"; (7) The Interim Final Rule entitled "Aliens Subject to a Bar Under Certain Presidential Proclamations, Procedures for Protection Claims" (83 Fed. Reg. 55934); (8) Presidential Proclamation 9822; (9) The Migrant Protection Protocols; (10) DHS Policy Memorandum 602-0169; and (11) Any regulation, policy, guideline, or practice applying the provisions of section 235(b)(2)(C) of the Immigration and Nationality Act (8 U.S.C.). In addition, to prohibit the use of federal funds to place in detention, remove, refer for removal, or initiate removal proceedings against participants in the Deferred Action for Childhood Arrivals initiative who continue to be qualified for such initiative or individuals granted temporary protected status who continue to be qualified for such status; and to conduct immigration enforcement activities at within 1,000 feet of specified locations.
