

Elliot Brandt AIPAC's Chief Executive Officer

Elliot Brandt is AIPAC's Chief Executive Officer. Prior to becoming CEO, Elliot served as Vice CEO, overseeing AIPAC's regional offices, the national development campaign, Events and Creative Services and Marketing and Communications.

Elliot joined AIPAC in 1994 in the Pacific Northwest office, serving in a number of roles including the Regional Director. In 2002, he moved to Los Angeles to serve as AIPAC's Western States Director overseeing a portfolio of thirteen states and the political activity and coalition building in more than 100 congressional districts.

Before joining AIPAC, Elliot worked in both the political and Jewish communities and coordinated the logistics for a company that airlifted medical supplies to Siberia and the Eastern Peninsula of the former Soviet Union. He also spent a year in Israel on the Otzma Fellowship, where he witnessed first-hand the effects of the Persian Gulf War, the wave of Russian immigration and the airlift and absorption of 14,000 Ethiopian Jews during Operation Solomon.

Elliot is a graduate of Stanford University, a Wexner Fellow and a past member of UJC's Leadership Cabinet. He currently lives with his wife in Washington, D.C.
