Victoria graduated from Haskell Indian Nations University in 2006 with a Bachelor of Science in Business Administration. Previous to Victoria's Tribal Council tenure, she served as the Internal Auditor for the Winnebago Tribe. Most recently, Victoria's work has been focused on advocating for systematic changes to the Indian Health Service and overall improved health care outcomes for tribal nations. Ms. Kitcheyan had the honor and privilege of providing testimony to The United States House Subcommittee On Indian, Insular, and Alaska Native Affairs regarding H.R. 5406, "HELPING ENSURE ACCOUNTABILITY, LEADERSHIP, AND TRUST IN TRIBAL July 12, 2016; The United States House of Representatives Committee on Appropriations, Subcommittee on Interior, Environment, and Related Agencies regarding Indian Health Service March 18, 2016; and The United States Senate Committee Indian Affairs Oversight Hearing on "REEXAMINING THE SUBSTANDARD QUALITY OF INDIAN HEALTH CARE IN THE GREAT PLAINS."
