Bryan is the President (Chairperson) of the Bay Mills Indian Community Executive Council. He has held that position since November 2017. As part of his duties as President of the Bay Mills Indian Community, he also serves on the Board of the Chippewa Resource Authority (CORA), which is a consortium of five (5) federally recognized Indian tribes that were signatories to the 1836 Treaty of Washington.

Prior to serving as President, Bryan Newland served as the Chief Judge of the Bay Mills Indian Community Tribal Court for four years. From 2009 through 2012, Bryan was a policy advisor to the Assistant Secretary of Interior for Indian Affairs.

Bryan Newland earned a law degree from Michigan State University College of Law in 2007, and earned his Bachelor of Arts degree from Michigan State University's James Madison College in 2003.
