Dr. Shaler currently serves on a range of national and state organizations including: Executive and Emerging Technology Committees of FORMaine, Executive Committee of the National Association of Forest Resource Programs (NAUFRP), Building, Housing, and Infrastructure working group of the Maine Climate Council, Ex-Officio member of the Maine Forests Products Council, and is a trustee of the Maine chapter of The Nature Conservancy. A Wisconsin native, he previously served on the faculty of Michigan Technological University after receiving his PhD in Forest Resources from Pennsylvania State University. His BS and MS in Wood Science & Technology are from Colorado State University.
