



Starting in November 2020, Andria Weeks has served as Acting Director for the USDA Forest Service's Office of Strategic Planning, Budget & Accountability. Ms. Weeks has focused on defending the agency's budget by fostering collaboration and communication with USDA, the President's Executive Office of Management and Budget, and Congressional staff. From budget formulation through accomplishment reporting, Ms. Weeks has provided expertise, strategic planning, and counsel to executive leadership to ensure successful achievement of the Forest Service mission since 2018 in her role as the Assistant Director.

Andria joined the USDA Forest Service in 2001 with the Office of Regulatory and Management Services and developed policy for forest management and National Environmental Policy Act compliance; and promulgation of regulations governing public land management planning. From 2008 to 2012, Andria was a Forest Service Legislative Affairs Specialist before becoming the Director of the Office of Regulatory and Management Services where she served from 2012 to 2018 overseeing the agency's regulatory agenda, congressional correspondence, records management, Freedom of Information Act and Federal Advisory Committee Act compliance.

Prior to her career with the Forest Service, Ms. Weeks spent 10 years with the Department of the Interior, National Park Service working as the regulatory officer, an audit liaison, and in human resources management.
