

TIM FAGAN DDS, MS

BIOGRAPHICAL INFORMATION

Tim Fagan DDS, MS is a specialist in Pediatric Dentistry and for 33 years has been in private practice in Enid, Oklahoma. He is a Clinical Professor and Head of the Pediatric Dentistry Division at the University of Oklahoma College of Dentistry in Oklahoma City. He is board certified by the American Board of Pediatric Dentistry. Dr. Fagan is the current Chairman of the American Dental Association Council on Advocacy for Access and Prevention, and a member of the ADA House of Delegates.

Dr. Fagan graduated from the University of Oklahoma College of Dentistry in 1981 and subsequently completed a one year General Dental Practice Residency at the University of Missouri at Kansas City. He completed his Pediatric Dentistry speciality training and obtained a Master of Science degree at the University of Iowa College of Dentistry in 1984.

He is a past President of the Southwestern Society of Pediatric Dentistry, Oklahoma Dental Association, and Garfield County (OK) Dental Association. Tim is a former trustee of the Board of Trustees of the American Academy of Pediatric Dentistry, and has served as Chairman of the AAPD Council on Continuing Education. He has served on the examination committee and as an examiner for the American Board of Pediatric Dentistry.

Dr. Fagan is a member of the American Dental Association, Oklahoma Dental Association, Northwest District Dental Association, American Academy of Pediatric Dentistry, Southwestern Society of Pediatric Dentistry, American College of Dentists, and the College of Diplomats of the American Board of Pediatric Dentistry.

Because of his interest in access to care issues, Tim was a member of the Oklahoma Governor's Task Force on Children and Oral Health Implementation Task Force from 2009-2014. He has participated in all eight of the Oklahoma Mission of Mercy events, and was chairman of the 2014 event held in Enid.

In 2015, Dr. Fagan was named the Outstanding Alumnus of the Year by the University of Oklahoma College of Dentistry. Last year he was the recipient of the Oklahoma Dental Association's Dan E. Brannin Award for Professionalism and Ethics.

Dr. Fagan and his wife Pamela have been married for 30 years and have three children and 4 grandchildren.
