

Erin Prangley is a Board Member of the Consortium for Citizens with Disabilities (CCD) and Co-Chair of the CCD Task Force on Developmental Disabilities, Autism and Family Supports. CCD is the largest coalition of national organizations working together to advocate for federal public policy that ensures the self-determination, independence, empowerment, integration and inclusion of children and adults with disabilities in all aspects of society.
