J.D. Rackey is an associate director with BPC's Structural Democracy Project where he works on the governing institutions and electoral systems portfolios. His research focuses on the politics and procedures of the U.S. Congress with an emphasis on congressional capacity and modernization. Rackey's work has appeared in scholarly journals such as *Political Science Today* and *Social Science Quarterly* and has been published or cited in popular press outlets such as The Washington Post, The Hill, and CQ Roll Call. He also currently serves as president of the National Capital Area Political Science Association.

Rackey previously served as professional staff with the U.S. House of Representatives Select Committee on the Modernization of Congress. He has also been an adjunct lecturer at Georgetown University. He earned his Ph.D. in Political Science from the University of Oklahoma and is a former American Political Science Association Public Service Fellow.
