

AMENDMENT TO H.R. 1960
OFFERED BY MS. SHEA-PORTER OF NEW
HAMPSHIRE

At the appropriate place in subtitle B of title III,
add the following new section:

1 **SEC. 3___.** **CLARIFICATION OF PROHIBITION ON DIS-**
2 **POSING OF WASTE IN OPEN-AIR BURN PITS.**

3 For the purposes of Department of Defense Instruc-
4 tion 4715.19, issued as required by section 317 of the Na-
5 tional Defense Authorization Act for Fiscal Year 2010
6 (Public Law 111-84; 10 U.S.C. 2701 note) or any suc-
7 cessor instruction, the term “covered waste” specifically
8 includes, in addition to the materials already specified in
9 subparagraphs (A) and (B) of subsection (c)(2) of such
10 section, the following:

- 11 (1) Tires.
- 12 (2) Treated wood.
- 13 (3) Batteries.
- 14 (4) Plastics, except insignificant amounts of
15 plastic remaining after a good-faith effort to remove
16 or recover plastic materials from the solid waste
17 stream.

1 (5) Munitions and explosives, the destruction of
2 which is covered in Department of Defense Instruc-
3 tion 6055.09-M (Reference (i)).

4 (6) Compressed gas cylinders, unless empty
5 with valves removed.

6 (7) Fuel containers, unless completely evacu-
7 ated of its contents.

8 (8) Aerosol cans.

9 (9) Polychlorinated biphenyls.

10 (10) Petroleum, oils, and lubricants products
11 (other than waste fuel for initial combustion).

12 (11) Asbestos.

13 (12) Mercury.

14 (13) Foam tent material.

15 (14) Any item containing any of the materials
16 referred to in a preceding paragraph.
