

AMENDMENT TO H.R. 1735

OFFERED BY MR. TURNER OF OHIO, Mr. Franks

At the appropriate place in title XXXI, insert the following new section:

1 SEC. 31 ____. LIMITATION ON AVAILABILITY OF FUNDS FOR
2 UNILATERAL DISARMAMENT.

3 (a) LIMITATION ON MAXIMUM AMOUNT FOR DIS-
4 MANTLEMENT.—Of the funds authorized to be appro-
5 priated by this Act or otherwise made available for any
6 of fiscal years 2016 through 2020 for the National Nu-
7 clear Security Administration, not more than \$50,000,000
8 may be obligated or expended in each such fiscal year to
9 carry out the nuclear weapons dismantlement and disposi-
10 tion activities of the Administration.

11 (b) LIMITATION ON UNILATERAL DISARMAMENT.—

12 (1) IN GENERAL.—Except as provided by para-
13 graph (2) and subsection (d), none of the funds au-
14 thorized to be appropriated by this Act or otherwise
15 made available for any of fiscal years 2016 through
16 2020 for the National Nuclear Security Administra-
17 tion may be obligated or expended to dismantle a
18 nuclear weapon of the United States.

1 (2) AUTHORIZED DISMANTLEMENT.—The limi-
2 tation in paragraph (1) shall not apply with respect
3 to a nuclear weapon of the United States that meets
4 at least one of the following criteria:

5 (A) The nuclear weapon was retired on or
6 before September 30, 2008.

7 (B) The Administrator for Nuclear Secu-
8 rity certifies in writing to the congressional de-
9 fense committees that the components of the
10 nuclear weapon are directly required for the
11 purposes of a current life extension program.

12 (C) The President certifies in writing to
13 the congressional defense committees that the
14 nuclear weapon is being dismantled pursuant to
15 a nuclear arms reduction treaty or similar
16 international agreement that—

17 (i) has entered into force after the
18 date of the enactment of this Act; and

19 (ii) was approved—

20 (I) with the advice and consent
21 of the Senate pursuant to Article II,
22 section 2, clause 2 of the Constitution
23 after the date of the enactment of this
24 Act; or

1 (II) by an Act of Congress, as
2 described in section 303(b) of the
3 Arms Control and Disarmament Act
4 (22 U.S.C. 2573(b)).

5 (c) LIMITATION ON UNILATERAL DISARMAMENT OF
6 CERTAIN CRUISE MISSILE WARHEADS.—Except as pro-
7 vided by subsection (d), and notwithstanding subsection
8 (b)(2), none of the funds authorized to be appropriated
9 by this Act or otherwise made available for any of fiscal
10 years 2016 through 2020 for the National Nuclear Secu-
11 rity Administration may be obligated or expended to dis-
12 mantle or dispose a W84 nuclear weapon.

13 (d) EXCEPTION.—The limitations in subsection (b)
14 and (c) shall not apply to activities necessary to conduct
15 maintenance or surveillance of the nuclear weapons stock-
16 pile or activities to ensure the safety or reliability of the
17 nuclear weapons stockpile.
