

**AMENDMENT TO H.R. 4909**  
**OFFERED BY MR. COFFMAN OF COLORADO**

Add at the end of subtitle F of title 28 the following:

1 **SEC. 28** \_\_\_\_. **AMENDMENTS TO THE NATIONAL HISTORIC**  
2 **PRESERVATION ACT.**

3 Section 101(a) of the National Historic Preservation  
4 Act (16 U.S.C. 470a(a)) is amended as follows:

5 (1) In paragraph (2)—

6 (A) in subparagraph (E), by striking “;  
7 and” and inserting a semicolon;

8 (B) in subparagraph (F), by striking the  
9 period and inserting “; and”; and

10 (C) by adding at the end the following:

11 “(G) notifying the Committee on Natural Re-  
12 sources of the United States House of Representa-  
13 tives and the Committee on Energy and Natural Re-  
14 sources of the Senate if the property is owned by the  
15 Federal Government when the property is being con-  
16 sidered for inclusion on the National Register, for  
17 designation as a National Historic Landmark, or for  
18 nomination to the World Heritage List.”.

19 (2) By redesignating paragraphs (7) and (8) as  
20 paragraphs (8) and (9), respectively.

1           (3) By inserting after paragraph (6) the fol-  
2           lowing:

3           “(7) If the head of the agency managing any  
4           Federal property objects to such inclusion or des-  
5           ignation for reasons of national security, such as any  
6           impact the inclusion or designation would have on  
7           use of the property for military training or readiness  
8           purposes, that Federal property shall be neither in-  
9           cluded on the National Register nor designated as a  
10          National Historic Landmark until the objection is  
11          withdrawn.”.

12          (4) By adding after paragraph (9) (as so redes-  
13          ignated by paragraph (2) of this section) the fol-  
14          lowing:

15          “(10) The Secretary shall promulgate regula-  
16          tions to allow for expedited removal of Federal prop-  
17          erty listed on the National Register of Historic  
18          Places if the managing agency of that Federal prop-  
19          erty submits to the Secretary a written request to  
20          remove the Federal property from the National Reg-  
21          ister of Historic Places for reasons of national secu-  
22          rity, such as any impact the inclusion or designation  
23          would have on use of the property for military train-  
24          ing or readiness purposes.”.
