

**AMENDMENT TO H.R. 2500**  
**OFFERED BY MS. SPEIER OF CALIFORNIA**

At the appropriate place in title VII, insert the following new section:

1 **SEC. 7 \_\_\_\_ . PREGNANCY PREVENTION ASSISTANCE AT MILI-**  
2 **TARY MEDICAL TREATMENT FACILITIES FOR**  
3 **SEXUAL ASSAULT SURVIVORS.**

4 (a) IN GENERAL.—Chapter 55 of title 10, United  
5 States Code, is amended by inserting after section 1074o  
6 the following new section:

7 **“§ 1074p. Provision of pregnancy prevention assist-**  
8 **ance at military medical treatment facili-**  
9 **ties**

10 “(a) INFORMATION AND ASSISTANCE.—The Sec-  
11 retary of Defense shall promptly furnish to sexual assault  
12 survivors at each military medical treatment facility the  
13 following:

14 “(1) Comprehensive, medically and factually ac-  
15 curate, and unbiased written and oral information  
16 about all methods of emergency contraception ap-  
17 proved by the Food and Drug Administration.

18 “(2) Notification of the right of the sexual as-  
19 sult survivor to confidentiality with respect to the

1 information and care and services furnished under  
2 this section.

3 “(3) Upon request by the sexual assault sur-  
4 vivor, emergency contraception or, if applicable, a  
5 prescription for emergency contraception.

6 “(b) INFORMATION.—The Secretary shall ensure that  
7 information provided pursuant to subsection (a) is pro-  
8 vided in language that—

9 “(1) is clear and concise;

10 “(2) is readily comprehensible; and

11 “(3) meets such conditions (including condi-  
12 tions regarding the provision of information in lan-  
13 guages other than English) as the Secretary may  
14 prescribe in regulations to carry out this section.

15 “(c) DEFINITIONS.—In this section:

16 “(1) The term ‘sexual assault survivor’ means  
17 any individual who presents at a military medical  
18 treatment facility and—

19 “(A) states to personnel of the facility that  
20 the individual experienced a sexual assault;

21 “(B) is accompanied by another person  
22 who states that the individual experienced a  
23 sexual assault; or

1                   “(C) whom the personnel of the facility  
2                   reasonably believes to be a survivor of sexual  
3                   assault.

4                   “(2) The term ‘sexual assault’ means the con-  
5                   duct described in section 1565b(e) of this title that  
6                   may result in pregnancy.”.

7                   (b) CLERICAL AMENDMENT.—The table of sections  
8                   at the beginning of such chapter is amended by inserting  
9                   after the item relating to section 1074o the following new  
10                  item:

                  “1074p. Provision of pregnancy prevention assistance at military medical treat-  
                  ment facilities.”.
