

AMENDMENT TO H.R. 4350
OFFERED BY MR. WALTZ OF FLORIDA

At the appropriate place in title VIII, insert the following new section:

1 **SEC. 8 ____ . PROHIBITION ON CERTAIN SALES BY MEMBERS**
2 **OR SPONSORS IN THE OLYMPIC PARTNER**
3 **PROGRAMME OF THE INTERNATIONAL OLYM-**
4 **PIC COMMITTEE.**

5 (a) SALES PROHIBITION.—

6 (1) IN GENERAL.—Effective 60 days after the
7 date of the enactment of this Act, a person that is
8 a member or sponsor in the Olympic Partner Pro-
9 gramme of the International Olympic Committee
10 may not sell any product made by such person on
11 a military installation.

12 (2) TERMINATION OF BUSINESS OPERATIONS.—

13 This section shall not apply with respect to a person
14 described in paragraph (1) that terminates member-
15 ship or sponsorship in the Olympic Partner Pro-
16 gramme of the International Olympic Committee
17 within 30 days after the date of the enactment of
18 this section.

19 (b) DEFINITIONS.—In this section:

1 (1) MILITARY INSTALLATION.—The term “mili-
2 tary installation” has the meaning given in section
3 2801 of title 10, United States Code.

4 (2) PERSON.—The term “person” means—

5 (A) a natural person, corporation, com-
6 pany, business association, partnership, society,
7 trust, or any other nongovernmental entity, or-
8 ganization, or group;

9 (B) any governmental entity or instrumen-
10 tality of a government, including a multilateral
11 development institution (as defined in section
12 1701(c)(3) of the International Financial Insti-
13 tutions Act (22 U.S.C. 262r(c)(3))); and

14 (C) any successor, subunit, parent entity,
15 or subsidiary of, or any entity under common
16 ownership or control with, any entity described
17 in subparagraph (A) or (B).

18 (c) TERMINATION.—This section and the require-
19 ments of this section shall terminate on—

20 (1) the date on which a determination is made
21 that the 2022 winter Olympics will not be held in
22 the People’s Republic of China; or

23 (2) September 30, 2025.
