**A BILL**

2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Empowering States  
5 to Protect Seniors from Bad Actors Act”.

1 **SEC. 2. FUNDING CLARIFICATION.**

2 Section 989A of the Dodd-Frank Wall Street Reform  
3 and Consumer Protection Act (12 U.S.C. 5537) is amend-  
4 ed—

5 (1) in subsection (a)(6), by striking “Office of  
6 Financial Literacy” and inserting “Office of Finan-  
7 cial Education”; and

8 (2) by striking subsection (h).
