NOTICE OF MEETING

The Committee on Financial Services will meet in open session at 10:00 a.m. on Wednesday, May 24, 2023, in room 2128 of the Rayburn House Office Building. The Committee will consider, in an order to be determined by the Chairman, the following measures:

1. H.R. 3556, the *Increasing Financial Regulatory Accountability and Transparency Act* (Barr)
2. H.R. 3564, the *Middle Class Borrower Protection Act of 2023* (Davidson)
3. H.R. 2622, a bill to amend the *Investment Advisers Act of 1940 to codify certain Securities and Exchange Commission no-action letters that exclude brokers and dealers compensated for certain research services from the definition of investment adviser, and for other purposes* (Sessions)
4. H.R. 1553, the *Helping Angels Lead Our Startups (HALOS) Act* (Lawler)
5. H.R. 3063, the *Retirement Fairness for Charities and Educational Institutions Act* (Lucas)
6. H.R. 2627, the *Increasing Investor Opportunities Act* (Wagner)

To the extent permitted by the rules and practices governing regular order, the Chairman will give priority recognition to a member for the purpose of offering an amendment if the member has filed such amendment at least 24 hours before the commencement of the meeting. To pre-file an amendment, the amendment must be emailed to the Committee's General Counsel, Rachel Collins (Rachel.Collins@mail.house.gov) by the deadline. Regardless of whether an amendment is pre-filed, any member wishing to offer an amendment must provide 100 copies of the amendment to the Clerk of the Committee at the meeting before the amendment is read for consideration.
