Background

During the peak of the Great Depression, Congress passed the Securities Act of 1933 (Securities Act) and the Securities and Exchange Act of 1934 (Exchange Act), which created the SEC. The SEC's mission is to: (1) protect investors; (2) maintain fair, orderly, and efficient markets; and (3) facilitate capital formation. In support of the SEC's mission, the Division seeks to ensure that investors are provided with material information in order to make informed investment decisions. This includes when a company initially offers its securities to the public and on an ongoing basis as it continues to give information to the marketplace. The Division also provides legal and accounting interpretive advice to the Commission regarding new rules and revisions to existing rules. In addition, the Division provides advice to companies, investors, and their advisors by issuing Staff Legal and Accounting Bulletins, staff Disclosure Guidance Topics, updates to the Division's Financial Reporting Manual, no-action and interpretive letters and Compliance and Disclosure Interpretations.¹

This hearing will examine the regulatory developments, rulemakings, and activities that the Division of Corporation Finance has undertaken during Chair Gensler's tenure at the Commission.
