

Katherine is Chair of 38 North Solutions. An international clean energy policy expert, Katherine was an original and longtime host of The Energy Gang podcast and is now a regular contributor to [The Carbon Copy](#) podcast. Katherine has led several councils of the [World Economic Forum](#) as a global policy and technology thought leader and is currently Chair of the [Global Future Council on Clean Electrification](#). Katherine served as President of the GridWise Alliance, advocating for smart grid funding in the Recovery Act. Prior to that role, Katherine was a policy advisor for Good Energies, Inc., a private investment company with a portfolio in clean energy technologies of nearly \$6 billion. She co-directed the American Bioenergy Association, working with the states of Maryland and New Jersey to develop renewable portfolio standards. Katherine spent a decade at Virginia Power, designing grids and managing commercial customer projects.
